

## MINISTRY OF THE WORD

What we hear from others will be stored in our mind and become a mind set or belief system. But unless we experience what they are saying, all it is-is a doctrine, a teaching that we believe.

When we receive revelation and understanding comes in our mind, it still does not mean it is the truth, because the truth is a person, the Lord Jesus Christ.

When we encounter the presence and person of God in the words we are hearing we partake of His divine nature and we enter into a oneness of spirit with Him, where he interpenetrates us, and we experience Christ in us.

*Galatians 2:<sup>20</sup> I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.*

Faith is the result of encountering the presence of God and it is a fruit of the life of God flowing into our spirit. It is the faith of the Son of God flowing into our spirit and it produces fruit that remains and stands the test of time.
