

RELATIONSHIP WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

When we understand the Holy Spirit's role and work in our life, we can develop a relationship with Him that covers every circumstance of life, every situation, every crisis, spiritual warfare, ministry and opportunity to advance the kingdom in the earth. We begin to know Him experientially in our life. We begin to share in His personality

The Holy Spirit's work is to develop who we are in Jesus. He will help us in every single thing that we face. The Holy Spirit reveals the nature of Jesus to us and opens our eyes to spiritually see it so that it is transferred to us through the infilling of His Spirit.

Jesus is in heaven interceding for us and the Holy Spirit is on earth living out those prayers in us. The Holy Spirit takes everything that is happening in heaven concerning us and making sure that we connect with it here on earth.

The Holy Spirit has an uncontainable joy in everything that heaven does. Joy is the environment of heaven. No one embodies that joy more than the Holy Spirit. He was there at the start of creation brooding over the face of the waters excited; we are going to create something. And He is even more excited about what He is going to create in our lives.

He thoroughly enjoys everything concerning us, every connection with us. He will enjoy breaking us and rebuilding us. The Holy Spirit has to get us to totally depend upon Him, so He will let us do our own thing so that we will fail and begin to look to Him. He has to break us from acting independently from Him.

He will enjoy being there for us on our worst day, when we feel that we have lost everything and we are in a ditch, we will soon find out that He will be in that same ditch with us revealing to us how to climb out.

When we learn how to walk in the Spirit, how to walk in Him, how to walk under the influence of His Spirit moving and flowing within us, then we can see Him smiling with the eyes of our spirit, feel Him radiating within us , feel His joy overflowing in us.

There will never be a day when He is not present in our life. We need to realize that the presence of God does not depend upon an emotion; it only depends upon a trust. We have to set our will to believe, to determine to believe to become aware of His Presence, we know what He feels like because He lives in us.

But there are times that the Holy Spirit withdraws from our soul so that we do not feel Him, but then we become more aware of our spirit and its senses are heightened. When we don't feel the Holy Spirit in our soul, then He causes us to be more aware of our spirit so that we can receive deeper truth in our spirit. This is called stillness.

When our soul is agitated and our thoughts are negative we learn how to get out of our self (soul) and live in our spirit. We have to become aware of our spirit.

When our spirit was born again we became conscious of God in it, but our soul is our unique individuality. It is our self-consciousness. Self awareness, self will, it has a thousand manifestations which we call the self-family. Self-justification, self-righteousness and so on, all these things are (our soul and body acting independently of God). So when

we are moving in self we are falling short of Gods glory, the essence of who He is, His divine nature.

And it is the Holy Spirits responsibility to impart the glory of God into our spirit, and this totally thrills and excites Him.

So the Holy Spirit has to teach us how to divide our soul from our spirit through His revealing and making the word of God alive and real to us.

The Holy Spirit makes the word come alive in our spirit so that we experience God's nature, His thoughts and feelings. Our spirit becomes conscious of, it encounters, experiences the essence of God, so that we taste of the Lord that He is good, we taste of His glory or nature or presence. We experience God in our spirit and when this happens our soul becomes aware of it.

The new born spirit has all the senses that our soul has, but they are not yet fully developed. Our spirit and soul are interrelated. Our spirit affects our soul and our soul affects our spirit. But what we receive from God comes into our spirit and then into our soul. The life of God flows into our spirit and then our soul and then our body.

Our soul senses are highly developed, so that we mostly feel with our soul. Joy is conceived in our spirit and then we can feel it in our soul.

Until our spirit is born again our soul has no awareness of God within us. When our spirit is born again God becomes real to us, we now have a personal relationship with Him. Before this we were not even aware that we had a spirit. And we just basically lived in our soul

according to the course of this world. And our soul has been trained and conditioned to live in independence of God.

When our spirit is born again, it is saved. The incorruptible seed of God was conceived in it. The Holy Spirit quickens the word so that it becomes alive in our spirit. As the word grows through the quickening of the Holy Spirit, Jesus is formed in our spirit. Once the Holy Spirit quickens the word in our experience, we experience God in the word and our spirit retains it. We experience the thoughts and feelings of God through the word the Holy Spirit quickens to us.

Once the word is quickened to our spirit, then the Holy Spirit can divide our soul from our spirit. We have experienced the thoughts and feelings of God in our spirit, now when we experience thoughts and feelings in our soul that are contrary to Gods Spirit, the Holy Spirit convicts us, we pause, we step back into our spirit looking to the Holy Spirit to direct our thinking and feelings. If we cannot feel the Holy Spirit then we just ignore what is going on in our soul and just live in our spirit the best we can until the feelings in our soul pass. If we focus on the negative we give it power.

When my soul is agitated or disturbed, I just start praying in tongues, I am immediately aware of my spirit, the Holy Spirit is giving me utterance and I can feel my spirit, I have victory in my spirit even though my soul is still agitated and it is only a matter of time until my soul comes in line.

When I pray in tongues my spirit prays because my understanding (soul) is not involved in this, unless I prophesy.

If a person says that tongues have passed away or are not from God, they do not yet know the Holy Spirit; they are still living in their soul, and may have religious spirits operating in them or doctrines of devils. The devil does not want us speaking in tongues because he knows how powerful it is.

If you do not yet speak in tongues, thank the lord every day, thank you lord for the ability to speak in tongues, and if you keep thanking the Lord every day, you will experience the manifest presence of God in such a way that you will become aware of your spirit and given the words to say. It is called being baptized in the Holy Spirit, being immersed in the presence of God.

I was all by myself and the presence of God just filled the atmosphere of my bedroom and I heard three Hebrew words in my spirit and just spoke them until I had a pray language. Every time I pray in tongues my spirit is built up, it strengthens my spirit because it is active in God.
