Lord take everything out of our heart that is in opposition or that may hinder intimacy with you, anything that may distract our focus, or disconnect the life line of your fullness flowing into and out of us.

Fill us with your Holy Spirit and your love so that there may be no room for anything else in our heart. In you alone is satisfaction and abundance of life.

Our soul longs for fulfillment. Many believers try to fill this longing with activities and meetings, with conferences, seminars, bible studies, good works, and so on and so forth. But the truth is our soul will not be satisfied until it has come into intimacy with God. This is something our spirit already knows, but our soul may yet have not experienced.

It is as our soul comes into the sanctification of the Spirit that our heart becomes pure and we begin to see God in order to know him. True success in life is becoming a whole hearted lover of God, and this requires an entering in beyond the veil.

God is calling us into intimacy, spirit, soul and body in that order. It's time to step out of the earthly realm and into the eternal realm of the Spirit.

“There is more, so much more, than what we have experienced.” We are called to dwell in the secret place of the Most High. To gaze upon His beauty, to find our home inside of His heart, this is the place of intimacy.

No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him. ~ 1 Corinthians 2: 9 But by His Spirit He is now revealing to us our destiny in Him.

It is only in moving out of our earthbound existence and into the Spirit that we enter into the fullness of intimacy. We will begin to enter into this place as we become wholly abandoned to Him.

Intimacy with God is a process and a journey. It is a journey into the Father's heart. It starts with having our spirit, soul and body gates cleansed and open to God.

We have to learn how to enter the courts of heaven and through the Spirit judge ourselves and have the accusers' accusations silenced, so that he has no place within us.

The division between heaven and earth, the veil between the realms has been forever torn by the Lord. But we need eyes to see, so that we can enter the unseen realm and be transformed through intimacy with God.

We have to go beyond knowing about Him through His word, where we begin to experience Him moment by moment in our daily lives.

All change comes through exposure to the Lord; it is as we enter into His presence that we are transformed. The veil has been torn so that we can enter in by faith. We do it by faith and as we begin to enter that realm, His presence is what opens our spiritual senses so that the unseen realm begins to be seen.

It is only as we begin to seek His face, that we will have face to face encounters with God.

God is calling us out of our earthbound state and into our spirit; it is here that intimacy is birthed.

It is as we begin to experience God inside of us that will open the door for us experiencing the heavenly realms outside of us. We have to become aware of the life of God flowing into our spirit, so that our spirit is strong and takes the ascendancy so that our soul will come into submission to our spirit.

The world around us is a world of outer relationships; we make friends, and develop relationships. But God wants to have a relationship that is more real to us than the people around us.

When we learn how to look with our spirit, God becomes visible and he begins to reveal himself to those who seek him.

So much of our 'time with the Lord' is geared to our soul. Music that stirs the soul, preaching that inspires the soul, sermons that challenge the soul.

But God is Spirit and we can only know him in the Spirit. The Lord says; "those who worship me must worship in Spirit." Our souls are being called into obedience to our spirit; we are being called into intimacy by the lover of our souls.

Glory can only be experienced by a soul that is yielded to our spirit. To become a whole person our soul must no longer act independently of the Lord. Union with Christ, spirit, soul and body, to be wholly sanctified is our goal, so that we may know Him and the hope of His calling. His inheritance in us.

WHAT IS INTIMACY? - "IN TO ME SEE." It is allowing God to look into our heart and God allowing us to look into His.
