

THE CALEB SPIRIT

We have to activate our spirit and tune into the Holy Spirit, so that an aspect of God's nature is revealed to us, so that we can tune into it and draw it into us.

We look at something and we are thinking, how do I overcome that? We no longer murmur and complain, we do not have a murmuring spirit. We have a different spirit.

We get excited because the joy of the Lord is our strength. We are not thinking oh no! What is our response? Look at that! This is going to be fun, how do I overcome it.

We are recognizing that the bigger the giant, the bigger we are going to be at the end of that fight. We are looking at it in a certain way, that giant is our doorway into a whole different realm, A place in the spirit that we can abide in.

This is why David ran towards goliath; he saw it was his destiny to overcome him. David had a word from the Lord that he would be king. He had the spirit of a king. And he sees this giant standing in the way of him becoming a king in the natural. He sees this giant as the opportunity to become the king of Israel faster.

We do not focus on the problem, but on what it will look like when God is inhabiting that space in our heart that is not working for us.

When we are under attack, and there is a stronghold in our life, we have to focus on letting God inhabit that area of our life. We have to learn how to receive under pressure.

We have to see who we are in the future; we have to bring our lives into submission to that. God has to reveal it, we have to see it, want it and move towards it, we want to possess it as fast as we can.

We have to learn the language of that person we are becoming; we have to learn the words that go with that identity, and the mindset we are to possess. We are reconciling ourselves to the person we are to become next.

In a walk with God we go from grace to grace, faith to faith, strength to strength, and glory to glory.

The grace of God flows into our spirit releasing revelation. In that revelation is the impartation of the faith of God to become the person that God says we are.
